## 2006 Merlot, Russian River, Richard McDowell Vineyard

With visions of Pétrus dancing in our heads, we ripped out the apples and planted Merlot. That was a few years ago. This is our Merlot Reserve - planted, grown, and bottled by Toad Hollow, the third bottling of our first reserve wine. Merlot does best in sandy, clay-like soils as proven in France in the province of Pomerol where it gives birth to the mighty Pétrus - the pinnacle of all Merlot wines. We had the soil, we had the cuttings, and we had the perfect medium temperature range preferred by the Merlot grape to do its very best. This wine is a keeper and will age beautifully.
